My Mission to London, 1912-1914,

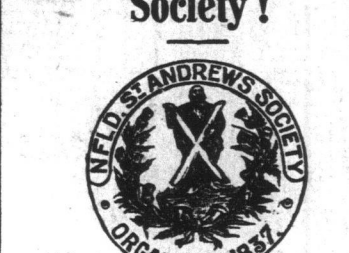
