HOW TO KEEP WELL

TO AN INFERIOR MOTHER nothing is more alarming than to see a child in the middle of the night by the struggles for breath and the cough of a croupy child. In the first place, the mother should know that the disease may be diphtheria. In the second, there is the child may choke to death.

Is there any way to tell a child is likely to develop into a croupy child? In the answer there is the family history. Croup runs in families. In the second, there is a history of convulsions or other nervous disorders in the family.

What can be done to prevent croup? A course of a month or two of calcium chloride is a valuable preventive. Three to fifteen grains of calcium chloride in water three times a day, according to the age of the child, should be given.
