A GREAT SUNDAY SCHOOL OFFERING.

The Superintendent of the Sunday school of the Church of the Holy Apostles, Philadelphia, U. S., has issued a letter to the teachers and pupils of the school, giving them an account of its extraordinary large Easter offering. The total amount of the offering was \$3,685.97. Of this sum \$3,520.90 was contributed for General Missions, for the glory of God and as a memorial of Dr. Langford.

"BLACK NETS WITH WHITE CORKS."

The adoption of what Bishop Selwyn termed "Black nets with white corks," that is the system of native teachers trained and directed by white men, is meeting with great success in New Guinea. Seven South Sea Islanders are now working as teachers in the Anglican Mission. They are regarded as "the parsons of the villages," and since their coming there have been no fights or cannibal feasts.

On Sunday evening, December 26, an event took place which marks an epoch in the history of the Mission, viz., the preaching of the Gospel by one of the New Guinea natives. Samuela, the first baptized convert of the Mission, had already given addresses at outdoor services at Wamira, and now preached to a full church at Dogura. He was not in the least embarrassed, and spoke well, making a good impression. Some of the illustrations he used were very quaint, but appeared to be effective upon his fellow countrymen.
