

TORONTO CRICKET CLUB v TRINITY COLLEGE SCHOOL ROVERS.

Played at Toronto on Friday last, resulted in a very sorry defeat for the visitors. Toronto took the field, and Helmcken knocked down the wickets with such success that the total was only 49, to which Logan (the captain) gave a good 24. Foy was weaker than usual. Twelve men a side were played, and two of Toronto's wickets went down for 5 before lunch, and 8 more afterwards for 5, so that when Morrison joined Brown as last man, the home team only led by two. Morrison soon set to work, and the field was widened. Brown played very steadily, as if to give Morrison a chance, but as soon as the century was telegraphed, he began to hit far more freely, and piled up his 64 without a chance, and in first-rate form. Meanwhile Morrison had been scoring very rapidly, and had got to almost the century when he skied one to Morris at 83, which was refused. At the 100 he was warmly applauded, and scored on after giving two more chances to the same man till Brown's wicket fell. It will be noticed that the last wicket produced 198 runs, of which Morrison got 133, not out. He was afterwards presented by the club with a bat. Score.

TRINITY COLLEGE SCHOOL ROVERS v. HAMILTON.

Kennedy won the toss for Hamilton, and sent the Rovers to the bat, Saunders and Allan facing the bowling of Gillespie and

Kennedy. In Gillespie's third over, Saunders was caught at the wickets off his glove, and Howard took his place, who, after making 5, was bowled by Gillespie. Hall followed, and in the following over Allan was clean bowled by Kennedy. Cayley then went in, and by some hard hitting soon run up 16, Hall in the meantime being caught at the wickets off his arm for 8. Macdonell, after scoring 5, put one into Harvey's hands. Morris, by very steady play, put together 13. Ince was quickly caught and bowled. Gillespie, Ross and Scott succumbed to the same bowler, leaving the captain not out 17, the total being 83. Hamilton's fielding was not up to the mark, some half a dozen catches being missed. Hamilton then sent in Hope and Cumming, to face Logan and Allan. After scoring 8, Hope was bowled by a shooter from Logan. No stand was made by any of the succeeding players, and the whole innings closed for 29. The Rovers' fielding was very good, not a single mistake being made, and no extras to add to the score.

The Rovers then went in for their second innings. Saunders was again caught out, Allan bowled by a beauty from Gillespie. Hall, his bad luck not deserting him, was caught off his pad.

Time being up, the match had to be stopped, leaving it a draw. Following is the score:
