In this example, Canada's (Header 1) total trade (Header 2) is presented for selected partner countries (printed across the top of the page) and for selected years (shown down the side of the page).

This report displays the value imported, value exported, trade balance (value exported - value imported) and total trade turnover (value exported plus value imported) for Canada, for the years 1968 to 1975. The partner countries (groups) selected were the world and the industrialized countries and four options were chosen.

Options

First Percentage Line - Percent Partner Country Total

In the year 1975, Canada imported \$28,929,360,000 US from all the Industrialized Countries. This represented 85.20% of Canada's total imports of \$33,953,888,000 US from the world.

Second Percentage Line - Annual Growth Rate

In 1975, the value of Canada's imports from the Industrialized Countries increased 4.73% from the 1974 import value of \$32,296,256,000 US.
