THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE CANADA-UNITED KINGDOM TAX AGREEMENT, WHICH HAS BEEN IN FORCE SINCE 1946, HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO COVER THE TERRITORIES OF KENYA, TANGANYIKA, UGANDA AND ZANZIBAR. THIS WAS FORMALLY EFFECTED BY AN EXCHANGE OF NOTES IN OTTAWA ON AUGUST 2, 1956, BETWEEN THE CANADIAN AND UNITED KINGDOM GOVERNMENTS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE EXISTING AGREEMENT. THIS EXTENSION RAISES TO 29 THE NUMBER OF COLONIAL TERRITORIES OF THE UNITED KINGDOM NOW COVERED BY THE AGREEMENT.

DETAILS REGARDING THE PROVISIONS AS WELL AS A LIST OF ALL THE TERRITORIES AFFECTED BY THE AGREEMENT WILL BE FOUND IN THE CANADA GAZETTE. THE AGREEMENT CAME INTO FORCE ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1956.
