CANADIAN DELEGATION TO PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURATION IN THE REPUBLIC OF PANAMA

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, announced today the composition of the Canadian delegation to the inaugural ceremonies of the new President of the Republic of Panama, His Excellency Doctor Nicolas Ardito Barletta. The Canadian delegation will be led by Mr. Chris Speyer, Member of Parliament, who will be accompanied by the Canadian Ambassador to the Republic of Panama, Mr. Francis Filleul and Mr. John W. Graham, Director General, Caribbean and Central America Bureau, Department of External Affairs.

The inaugural ceremonies of President Barletta will take place in Panama on October 10 and 11, 1984.
