PRAYERS.

Three petitions were laid on the Table.

Mr. Weir (Melfort), a Member of the King's Privy Council, presented,—Return to an Address to His Excellency the Governor General, of the 20th October, 1932, for a copy of all telegrams, correspondence, letters and documents exchanged between the Department of Agriculture at Ottawa, and the Quebec Government, since August, 1930, in connection with interprovincial conferences at Ottawa and Toronto on the methods of farm co-operation.

And also,—Return to an Address to His Excellency the Governor General, of the 20th October, 1932, for a copy of all telegrams, correspondence, letters, reports and all other documents exchanged between the Department of Agriculture at Ottawa, and the Quebec Government, since 1921, in connection with the English embargo on our potatoes and cattle.

Mr. Stewart (Leeds), a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Governor General,—Report of the Minister of Public Works on the works under his control for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1932.

He also presented,—Return to an Order of the House of the 19th October, 1932, for a statement of the expenditures authorized and incurred by the Department of Public Works in the county of Bonaventure since last session, with each and every case, the name of the contractor, the amount of the contract, the name of the overseers of the works and whether such works were done by contract or day labour, and on whose recommendation.

Mr. Gordon, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copies of Orders in Council passed under the provisions of the Unemployment and Farm Relief Continuance Act, 1932, as follows:—

Order in Council, P.C. 2414, dated 31st October, 1932: authorizing payment to the Province of Nova Scotia of \$411.05 for direct relief.
