notice sent by registered letter shall be mailed in time to reach its destination not later than two weeks before the consideration of the proposed bill by the committee to which it may be referred; and proof of compliance with this requirement by the applicants shall be established by statutory declaration.

Additional notice.

(2) In addition to the notice in the Canada Gazette aforesaid, a similar notice shall also be published in some leading newspaper as follows:

In case of incorporation.

Railway or canal company.

Telegraph or telephone company. (a) When the application is for an Act to incorporate:

(i) A railway or canal company: in the principal city, town or village in each county or district, through which the proposed railway or canal is to be constructed;

(ii) A telegraph or telephone company: in the principal city or town in each province or territory in which the company proposes to operate;
