DISSECTION OF UPPER LIMB.

Body on Face for 4 Days.

1st Day.

Superficial Fascia and Cutaneous Nerves of Back.

Trapezius.

2nd Day.

Latissimus Dorsi.

Reflect Trapezius in conjunction with dissectors of Head and Neck

Nerve supply to Trapezius, Transversalis Colli Artery and Branches.

Rhomboids and nerve-supply.

Levator Anguli Scapulæ and Omo-Hyoid.

Supra-Scapular Artery and Nerve.

Reflect Latissimus dorsi and Rhomboids.

Follow **Posterior Scapular Artery** to its termination.
