

**BEACHES ARRANGE
RED CROSS DAY**

Scarboro Park Given Over to
Women, Who Will Utilize
Every Portion.

HOLD WATER CARNIVAL

Prizes Will Be Given for Best
Illuminated Craft Enter-
ing Contest.

The Beaches Red Cross Day was organized by the Beaches branch of the Women's Patriotic League to raise funds for their winter's Red Cross work, which is carried on at the headquarters, the Masonic Temple, Balsam avenue. The officers are Mrs. J. W. Barker, president; Mrs. W. A. Lambie, treasurer; and Mrs. J. S. Miller, 39 Balsam avenue, secretary, with a strong executive committee of women of the beach and a membership of about 600 volunteer workers.

Since August, 1914, they have raised about \$800, and have made large consignments of Red Cross supplies to the front thru the Women's Patriotic League, and the Red Cross Society. They have also contributed in money and goods to the Belgian Relief Fund, have endowed cots in the Rou Crisp Hospital, have looked after urgent cases needing relief in the Beaches district and have given employment to needy women for the past year.

They have no salaried officials, and every cent collected goes without any expense to whatever purpose it is expended.

Thru the kindness of the Scarboro Beach Company, all sales from tickets and the proceeds from special shows go to this fund on Red Cross days, Wednesday, August 18.

Special Events.

As Ashdown took a boat out on the lake yesterday and went to Lake Simcoe, presumably to visit his daughter Jessie, who was summering there. Mr. Ashdown was born in Toronto 41 years ago. He leaves a widow, three daughters and three sons. The eldest son, Mr. V. E. Ashdown, is a member of the Northern Ontario Mounted Rifles and was killed in the Northwest Rebellion in 1885 with the 1st Royal Grenadiers and tried to enter with the first contingent during the present war, but was refused on account of his age.

**HAD TO INCREASE
NUMBER OF STAFF**

Volunteers Storm New Recruiting Office Opened in Armories Yesterday.

PARADE THRU STREETS

Brass and Bugle Bands Lead Eighty-Third on First Route March.

Hundreds of men who wanted to enlist stormed the Toronto Recruiting Depot at the Armories yesterday when the inauguration of a new system of examining, enrolling, attesting and paying recruits. The office was practically open from 9 a.m. until 10 p.m., and the day's staff of 30 had to be increased to nearly 40 in order to handle the 500 men who wanted to "join the colors."

World announced that 143 men had been "sworn in" for active service. On being sworn in, the recruit is given an attestation slip, which is part of the new system. It also directs him to a regularly attested recruit. It also directs him to report for duty at 3:45 a.m. the next day. Of the several hundred who came to the depot's examination, a great number "failed" on account of defective eyesight.

Five Doctors Busy.

During the morning the rush of recruits kept the doctors busy examining them. Lieut.-Col. F. W. Marlow, A.D.M.S., was present part of the first week.

Lieut.-Col. Brook and Lieut. Legend directed the general work of the depot.

The first recruit who was accepted was Walter Ains, 48 St. Nicholas street, a laborer, born in England. After his name had been taken he was examined, certified fit, and completely sworn in within half an hour from the time he entered the depot.

He joined the York Rangers.

A feature of the depot is a bulletin board showing the names of men from the different regiments.

There is a large room where the men are medically examined, and it is so arranged that the recruits can be measured, weighed and tested in orderly succession, and also with great speed. Some of the doctors can "put a man thru" the medical examination in less than five minutes.

A military order filed at the recruiting depot stated that K. Logan, Hamilton, C. I., was enlisted in the Royal Canadian Dragoons, Royal Canadian Regiment, "consent" of parent or wife is not necessary.

First Route March.

With its brass and bugle bands in the lead, the 83rd Overseas Battalion held their first route march yesterday.
