As other illustrations may be mentioned asthma, pericarditis, pleurisy, appendicitis.

## GROUP VII.—ARTIFICIAL CIRCLES

To this Group are relegated such Circles as do not arise in the natural course of disease but are artefacts. Many such are dependent on social customs; for others, alas! injudicious treatment has been responsible.

Numerous examples belonging to this Group will be found in the following pages. A few striking ones are collected in Chapter XIV. Let us hope that such atrocities as are there referred to will soon lose all but a historical interest, and that the day will soon dewn when the practitioner of medicine will merit at any rate in some measure the high eulogium pronounced upon him by Hippocrates:

Ίατρός γὰρ φιλόσοφος ἐσόθεος.
