Great Gathering in Exhibition Park in Honor of Canada's Natal Day.


FRIENDLY CONTESTS IN AFTERNOON

Who Were Hidden Behind a Stockade and Now a Serious Uprising is Threatened.


BODY REMAINED IN THE ROAD


