NEW LIGHT-HOUSES.

An Act directed by the Commissioners of Light-Houses for the Bay of Fundy to request you will publish for the information of Mariners, the enclosed list of Light-Houses erected and lighted by the Province of Nova Scotia last year, and re-insert the description of a Light on Peter's Island, in Grand Passage, published in your journal and other city papers in 1850.

Eddy or Sandpoint Light.

A Beacon Light on Eddy or Sandpoint, on the West side of the South entrance to the Bay of Fundy, and is designed by Two White Lights horizontally placed 25 feet above Sea Level—base and fall 6 feet. The building is square, painted White with a Black Diamond on the seaward side. The Point is about Eastward of the Light nearly 500 yards, but the North side of the point is irregular, and the Tides are irregular, and very rapid round the Point.

Arichat Beacon.

A Beacon Light on Point Marconi, on the East side of the Southern entrance to the Bay of Fundy. The building is square, painted White, and shows a White Light 34 feet above Sea Level—base and fall 6 feet. The Point is about Eastward of the Light nearly 500 yards, but the North side of the point is irregular, and the Tides are irregular, and very rapid round the Point.

Horton Bluff Light.

A Beacon Light on Horton Bluff, in the Basin of Miramichi, 50 feet above sea level, high water—base and fall 4 to 45 feet. The building is square, painted White, stands 40 feet from the bluff, and shows a White Light, which may be seen in clear weather from the greatest part of the Basin of Miramichi. The Point is about Eastward of the Light nearly 500 yards, but the North side of the point is irregular, and the Tides are irregular, and very rapid round the Point.

Port Medway Light.

A Beacon or Harbour Light has been erected on Admiralty Head, on the West side of the entrance of Port Medway. The building is square, painted White, with a Black Diamond on the seaward side, and shows a White Light 34 feet above Sea Level—base and fall 6 feet. The Point is about Eastward of the Light nearly 500 yards, but the North side of the point is irregular, and the Tides are irregular, and very rapid round the Point.

Peter's Island Light.

A Beacon Light on Peter's Island, at the East end of the Strait of Canso, in the Bay of Fundy. The building is square, painted White, and shows a White Light 34 feet above Sea Level—base and fall 6 feet. The Point is about Eastward of the Light nearly 500 yards, but the North side of the point is irregular, and the Tides are irregular, and very rapid round the Point.
