


Arthur Hind of Utica Obtained British Guiana Prize of the Ferrari Collection — Is

King George of England was a bidder through an agent for a British Guiana postage stamp which recently sold for more than \$32,000 at the auction sale in Paris of the Ferrari collection, but the prize was obtained for Arthur Hind of Utica, according to Charles J. Phillips, who arrived here last week from London as a delegate from the London Rotary Club to the International Rotary Convention in Los Angeles from June 5 to 10.

Mr. Phillips is known among stamp collectors not only as the head of the Stanley Gibbons firm of London, probably the largest stamp dealers in the world, but also as the author of many authoritative works on philately.

"There is more money in America than abroad," said Mr. Phillips yesterday at the Hotel Biltmore, "and that is the reason why his Majesty King George was disappointed in not obtaining what is acknowledged to be the scarcest of all postage stamps. I feel safe in saying that his collection of the stamps of Great Britain and the British Colonies is the finest in the world."
