RAILWAY BOND ISSUE

Washington, April 26.—The interstate commerce commission yesterday granted authority to the Northern Pacific and Great Northern Railway Company to issue \$220,000,000 joint fifteen-year convertible gold bonds not less than twenty-one and a half per cent, and authorized each of the companies to pledge \$30,000,000 of other bonds to aid in securing the joint bonds. The issue was authorized to enable the two roads to retire joint bonds amounting to \$215,227,000 issued in 1907 for the purpose of purchasing the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railway.

GROCERY REPORTS

The following comment on the market situation as regards food stuffs appeared in Canadian Grocer last week: Business in wholesale circles during the week under review has shown a better tone and an improved movement is noted. Retail business has also been better, apparently retail trade has gained more confidence, buying more freely as the markets are gradually showing a greater tendency towards stabilization. There are no new developments in the sugar market, refined sugar is steady at the refiners' price basis although many wholesalers are selling at irregular quotations. The raw sugar market has been fairly steady during the week. The egg market has firmed up with prices higher. Other reductions in some extent to storage operations becoming more general. Butter is weak and lower prices are likely. Hogs and hog products are also weak with lower prices in sight.

HARDWARE PRICES

(Hardware and Metal, April 23.) Price changes continue on many hardware lines this week. Galvanized wares, including pails, tubs, and garbage cans are reduced in price. Other reductions include plated tubs, barrel bolts, shelf brackets, wheelbarrows, drag scrapers, seine twine and coil oil. Lower quotations are made on some makes of wash boards, tatchet chains and steel squares. A BAN ON IMMIGRATION.
(Bangor Commercial.) Secretary Hughes, in official papers submitted to congress, recommends rigid restriction of immigration, and his announcement is taken to favor the immediate passage of the immigration bill which limits for a period of fourteen months immigrants of any nationality to three per cent of the number of that nationality now resident in this country. The sentiment in Washington has been steadily growing in favor of a better control of immigration and it seems pretty evident that the measure that has been reported by the house committee on immigration will be adopted as a source of temporary relief while a permanent measure is being framed and adopted.

For lack of transportation and because of difficulty in obtaining passports there has been considerable restriction of immigration since the war, but these conditions are now changing and unless a drastic legal restriction is imposed we shall witness such an influx of foreigners as we have never known in the past. This will be especially true from the northern and central European countries. Secretary Hughes points out that these classes now wishing to come from these countries are not of a desirable type, and it seems to be the case that the authorities of some of these countries are encouraging the exit from their peoples.

The United States does not desire to be a dumping ground and if such is to be avoided prompt and drastic action is necessary.
