

London, Dec. 11—Attention is being called to the fact that Canadian nickel is being exported indirectly through the United States to Germany. The difficulty which would arise between the governments of Great Britain and the United States through any arrest of such cargoes on the high seas renders the stoppage of the trade impossible by that means, but the suggestion is advanced that the easiest way would be for the Canadian government to extend prohibition of the exportation of nickel, already in force as regards most European countries, to the United States.
