U. S. Canada's Best Customer Last Month
(Canadian Press Despatch.)
Ottawa, Feb. 25.—The United States was Canada's best customer during January, purchasing \$30,270,860 of Canadian products, as against \$21,104,716 in January of last year, according to a summary of trade with that country issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. During last month, however, Canada's purchases in the United States out-distanced her sales to that country by nearly \$19,000,000, the total of American goods imported being \$49,142,839, as against \$30,270,860 in January of last year and \$31,623,917 in the corresponding months of the previous year. Foreign products exported to United States last month were valued at \$82,235, as against \$749,463 in January last year.
