

BY-LAWS

OF THE

DOMINION GRANGE.

ARTICLE I.

The second day of June, the birthday of the Dominion Grange, shall be celebrated as the anniversary of the Order.

ARTICLE II.

At the annual meeting of each Subordinate Grange, the members shall elect two delegates besides the Master, to represent them in Division Grange, and at the annual meeting of each Division Grange the members shall elect one or more delegates to represent them in Dominion Grange in proportion of one delegate to every five Subordinate Granges composing such Division Grange. Provided that in counties where there are less than five Subordinate Granges that do not belong to Division Granges, such Grange or Granges may elect one delegate to represent them in the Dominion Grange and shall report such action, duly certified immediately to the Secretary of the Dominion Grange.

ARTICLE III.

Questions of Administration and jurisprudence arising in and between Division Granges and appeals from the action and decision thereof, shall be referred to the Master and Executive Committee of the Dominion Grange, whose decision shall be respected and obeyed until overruled by action of the Dominion Grange.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

ARTICLE IV.

Master.—It shall be the duty of the Master to preside at meetings of the Dominion Grange; to see that all officers and members of Committees properly perform their respective duties; to see that the Constitution, By-Laws and Resolutions of the Dominion Grange, and the usages of the Order, are observed and obeyed, draw all orders upon the Treasurer, subject to instructions of Executive Committee, and generally to perform all duties pertaining to his office.

ARTICLE V.

Secretary.—It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep a record of all proceedings of the Dominion Grange; to keep a just and true account of all moneys received by him, and hand the same over to the Treasurer monthly, and take his receipt therefor, and to make a full report of all transactions to the Dominion Grange at each annual session; he shall also prepare and issue a quarterly circular containing the reports from each Division Grange, and all other matters of interest to the Order, and address one or more copies to each Secretary of Subordinate and Division Granges, and shall further conduct correspondence of the Grange, and perform all duties appertaining to his office as required by Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VI.

Treasurer.—SEC. 1. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to pay all orders drawn upon him by the Master, countersigned by the Secretary.

SEC. 2. The Treasurer shall present to the annual meeting of the Dominion Grange a detailed account of all moneys received and paid out, with balance on hand; and shall at any time deliver up all moneys, books, papers, etc., pertaining to his office or in his possession, upon order of the Master under direction of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VII.

Executive Committee.—It shall be the duty of the Executive Committee to exercise a general supervision over the affairs of the Order, having authority to act on all matters of interest when the Dominion Grange is not in session; may appoint deputies as occasion requires, and shall direct the payment of all moneys from Dominion Treasury, and shall present a detailed account of all their acts to the Dominion Grange on the first day of its Annual Session.

The Master and Secretary of the Dominion Grange shall be considered ex-officio members of the Executive Committee.
