The telephone line between Newcastle and Caxham has been completed. About \$400,000 worth of new sailings are going up in New Glasgow, N. S. It is reported that a vein of coal has been struck near Alma, Albert Co. The N. S. cherry season has been very good this year, something like 20,000 boxes having been exported.

At a meeting of rikers, in Paris, the secretary announced no funds, and each man was free to act as he thought fit. The majority voted to resume work. The strike is ended.

The heaviest salmon caught in the Tay, two weeks ago, it was 4 ft. 5 in. long, 28 in. in girth and weighed 52 lb. A fifty pound fish has been caught in the Hants Avon, at Christ Church, near Salisbury.

It is stated upon the best authority that the proposed railroad contract between the Manitoba government and the Northern Pacific is in the latter declining to enter the province except at the unanimous wish of the people.

The governor general has issued orders for a ball at the Quebec Citadel on Sept. 4. The 'Thingalla' and 'The Geiser'—two Danish steamers, collided off Sable Island, N. S., on the 14th. The 'Geiser' sank and 72 passengers and crew were lost.

An interesting discovery has just been made by Dr. Teichkott, Professor of Church History in the University of Konigsberg, who has found in the library there numerous manuscript sermons, and commentaries by Luther, hitherto absolutely unknown.

The twelve thousand Hibernian ministers in the Methodist Episcopal Church are to have contributed, last year, \$109,000 of the missionary money paid in or on their behalf.
