Crystal Palace, which made him favorably known to the American people. He visited Quebec also at that time, and was the guest of the Earl of Elgin. He expired at Bridgewater house, st James, on Wednesday, the 18th March, 1857. The deceas d was born on the first January, 1.00.

The Right Revd. George Jehosaphat Mountain, D.D., D, CL., Lord Bishop of Que ec, was the second son of Bishop Ja ob Mountain, the first Anglica bi-hop of Queb.c. He was born 27th July, 1789, a Norwich, Englind, came to Canada with his father, 1703, and died after a brief illness at Bardfield, hi country seat, on 5th Jany, 1863. He was nine-teen years Restor of Queb.c. and was consecrated ishop 14th February, 1836. He was a diligent visitor amon his flock, and in the dreadful vi itations of hotera in 1832 and 1834, he literally lived night and day. among the dying nd the d ad while in 1847, when the rovince was vi ited with the plague of typhus fever, and the poor emigrants were dying y thous nds at the Quara tin station, the B shop took his turn at Grosse I. e regularly with the r st of the cle gy; and again when the choler, visited Quebec, 1849 and 1854 he was dilig nt in visiting the hospitals. During many year- and up to the time of his death, Bi hop Moun ain, besides his Lif members ip, contributed regularly to the Society a donati n equal to four annual subsc iptio s, and at all times took a great inter st in its proc edin s.
