to remit to the General Treasurer the amount of monies so received by them, once in every six months.

9.—The General Committee shall prepare and present to the Annual Meeting a Report of the proceedings, successes, and prospects of this Society, accompanied with such other information relative to the Methodist Missions generally, as may be deemed necessary. The Report, if approved by the Annual Meeting, shall be printed and circulated, together with a list of contributions received in Newfoundland.

10.—In order that the names of Annual Subscribers of One Pound and upwards, with the amount of contributions raised, may be received in London sufficiently early to be printed in the General Report of the year, the accounts of each station shall be closed not later than the 15th November; and the superintendant missionary of each station shall cause an alphabetical list of subscribers of the above class, with the total amount of receipts, to be forwarded to the General Secretaries of this Society.
