I beg to submit the names of a few Indians of the Red Bank Reserve that wish to have permits to cut 15 cords of spruce and cedar shingle wood, each, on the Red Bank Reserve. These names are

Thos. Cloud  
Frank Ward

Geo. Ward, and Geo. Peter Paul wishes to cut 10 cords of firewood. Joe Augustine wishes to cut 200 hardwood ties. This wood is all for sale. Could you possibly waive the collection of stumpage on this wood for this year as the price is small and the times are very hard for the Indians. I do not expect that they will be able to get this wood out, unless the weather improves, but they would like to try, and for the sake of giving them something to do I would recommend that it would be advisable to allow them the permits.
