

MARCOTTE, CHAS. (*L'Islet*.)

First returned to Parliament for present seat at last g.e. A Conservative, and a supporter of Mr. Chapleau.—*L'Islet, P.Q.*

MARION, JOSEPH, N.P. (*L'Assomption*.)

First returned to Parlt. for present seat in 1880, on death of sitting member. Re-elected at last g.e. by acclamation. A Conservative, and a supporter of Mr. Chapleau.—*St Paul l'Ermite, P.Q.*

MARTEL, MICHAEL DOSITHEE STANISLAS, M.D., J.P. (*Chambly*.)

Descended from a long established family in Quebec, who came from Normandy about 1700. S. of the late Jean Martel, Esq. B. at Vercheres, P.Q., 11 Jan. 1838. Ed. at Montreal College. M. Dlle. Marie Rose-de-Lima Senecal, of St. Hubert, 24 Sept. 1863. Received degree of M.D. from Victoria University, Montreal, 1865. Has been a Councillor of Chambly since 1869, and Mayor. Is a Justice of the Peace; Capt. V.M., and Presdt. of the St. Jean Baptiste Society. First returned to Parlt. at g.e. 1878; unsated on petition and defeated. Re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative, and supporter of Mr. Chapleau's Government.—*Chambly Basin, P.Q.*

McSHANE, JAMES J.P. (*Montreal West*.)

S. of James McShane and Ellen Quinn, who came from the Co. Armagh, Irel., but who have lived in Montreal for over 45 years. Father carried on business as cattle dealer, packer and exporter of meats to England and the U.S., but has retired from business for the last 13 years. B. in St. Josephs, City of Montreal. Ed. in Montreal by the late Daniel Mahoney, school teacher, and finished course of studies at St. Sulpician College (College St.), Montreal. M., 1863, Elizabeth Jane Danaugh, of Montreal, who died 26 June 1867; again in Plattsburgh, N.Y., to Josephine Katheline Meron, 8 Jan. 1868. Merchant and exporter of live cattle to all parts of England. Was the first to buy and ship cattle from Canada to England, in 1874—a branch of trade which has grown to large proportions. Was made a Justice of the Peace, in 1864, by Hon. T. D. McGee. Elected Councillor and Alderman for St. Ann's Ward for 11 years, and is now an Alderman. First returned to Parlt. at g.e.
