

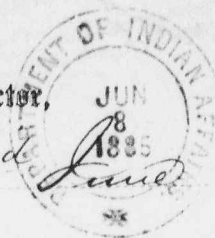

19465 I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo relative to parties having liquor in their possession on a highway running through an Indian Reserve in Manitoba and have noted its contents.

With regard to your last paragraph in said letter, I am unable to furnish you with the information asked for, relative to the authority upon which the Patents in question were obtained inasmuch as there is no correspondence in this Office, nor in the Lands Department here in reference to the same, but, I understand that they were issued direct from the Department of the Interior to the different parties who obtained them.
