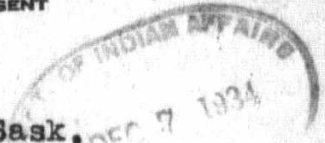

Dear Sir:

In reply to Department letter #23114-3, dated the 19th inst regarding the application of the Pasqua Band for an amount of \$500 of their surplus Interest money to be expended on road making on the Reserve, I beg to state that the roads on the Reserve needed fixing up and straightening out, and the work was very necessary.

To complete the work, a further sum of \$300.00 is necessary, and a resolution signed by the Chief and Councillors of the Band is enclosed herewith.

The work is being done under the supervision of the Farming Instructor and myself.

Besides improving the roads considerably the wages earned by the Indians will provide them with winter clothing and some food, and as the crops were very light this year, this will be a great help to them.

I would be very glad if the Department would send the \$800.00 asked for, as soon as convenient.
