Dear Sir:-

With reference to your letter of March 29th, requesting permission to graze cattle and horses on certain property in the Dundurn Reserve, I would point out that only a small portion of the land which you have requested is presently under the control of this Department;- namely;- N. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 5, Sec. 8, N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9.

Permission is granted for the grazing of cattle on this land. The remainder, I believe, now comes under the Department of the Interior.
