AT CLOSING OF AIR TRAINING PLAN—The Earl of Athlone, Governor General of Canada, and The Princess Alice, are shown being greeted by Air Marshal Robert Leckie, C.B., D.S.O., D.S.C., and D.F.C., Chief of the Air Staff, Royal Canadian Air Force, and Mrs. Leckie as they arrived at No. 2 S.F.T.S. Uplands, on Thursday afternoon for the symbolic wings parade ceremony, marking the close of training under the British Commonwealth Air Training Plan.
