A Council was held on  
 Aug. 1914. in presence of the Indian Agent  
 Henry James Coy - A motion was made  
 by one of the Councillors to ask your  
 Dept to grant a Permit to Nyles

 being made - I oppose this - as your  
 letter to William Tomico - who made  
 a complaint against Nyles Mr. Donald  
 last month, states a Surrender should  
 be made, the Agent told them to try  
 and get a Permit, with out a Surrender  
 being made - I would not sign the Petition  
 and Nyles Mr. Donald has been drawing  
 gravel now about four years - with out  
 permission from your Dept. he should  
 be fine - instead of allowing him to  
 go on - he offers 25<sup>cts</sup> per cord as does  
 our Agent is very anxious to give him  
 a permit with out a Surrender being
