Dear Mr King,

I am extremely sorry I have not been able to write to you earlier. I returned from India on the 29<sup>th</sup> April after getting married — a duty which almost every Hindu religiously performs. I hope you received the invitation letter I sent you from Calcutta.

The reason why I could not write to you earlier was that I fell ill at Geneva while on my way to London after leaving the steamer at Marseilles, and I did not keep good health for about a month <sup>afterwards</sup>. Then came the Coronation and I was kept so busy with the large number of Indian friends and relations who came over for the Coronation. And the number of social engagements one had to keep!! I am quite tired of them.
