

that you were not entitled to any living allowance while you were on leave in Toronto, and the same Order in Council that informed you - of which you were very ready to take advantage - of the rate of \$10⁰⁰ being allowed you while travelling in the North West, also showed that the rate while travelling in Ontario was only \$5⁰⁰ per diem. Consequently you were not justified in charging \$10⁰⁰ per diem while on duty at Ottawa. You will be required to refund the amount overpaid, and the Department is, therefore, holding back your salary until the whole amount overpaid has been refunded.
