he states that the facilities for doing this are not as get as formerly, owing to the fact that at present the Indiana do not own many cattle. Such moneys as are collected will be paid over to the Massey Herris Company. While willing to facilitate the collection of debts contracted by Indiana, the Department assumes no responsibility. I may add that I think it well to warm you that in future before you sell machinery to Indiana, it would be well for you to communicate with the Department direct, or with the Local Indiana Agent in charge of the Indiana.
