If the empty weight C.G. of a particular airplane of model J3C-65 falls within the range given, and the placard, "Solo flying in rear seat only," is installed, it is not necessary to check the critical forward and aft loading conditions. If the empty weight C.G. does not fall within the empty weight C.G. limits given, those conditions should be checked to determine whether the airplane will remain within the approved C.G. limits. In cases where it is possible to load an airplane in a manner not covered herein (i.e. extra tanks, extra seats, etc.) the usual complete calculations should be made.
