Vaccination.

The ten illustrations are from photographs taken by Park Bros., Toronto. The patient, an infant, was vaccinated on April 7th, 1900, by Dr. Rowena G. D. Hulme, with glycerinated vaccine manufactured by Mulford. The first photo was taken immediately after vaccination, the others in each of the succeeding days with the exception of the 4th and 11th days which were Sundays. In every respect the progress of vaccination is normal and the illustrations may be taken as accurately showing what happens in the case of a normal vaccination.
