Time. - The course will extend throughout the month of July, com-

mencing on Monday, the 2nd, and ending on the 31st.

Expenses, Etc.—There will be no tuition fee. Teachers to the number of 50, male or female, will be provided with rooms and board in the College, for which there will be a charge of \$12, payable in advance to the Bursar. Washing will be done in the College laundry and charged extra at moderate rates. Sheets and towels, four of each, must be provided by applicants for admission.

The surroundings of the College are pleasant, and of such a character that, in addition to the direct instruction gained by attendance upon lectures, much valuable information may be acquired by observation in the different departments of the Institution—the farm,

dairy, arboretum, gardens, greenhouses, laboratories, etc.
