JANUARY.—Considering that, on the whole, Canada has been providentially favoured with a bountiful harvest during the past year, it is well that our farmers should be cautioned against extravagance of expenditure and recklessness of speculation. Many will have difficulty recovering themselves from the losses of the last three or four years, but others who have been able to get along without incurring heavy debts may be tempted to error in regard to future operations. Now the Almanac whispers words of wise caution to the prosperous. Be diligent, but be careful. It is not possible to foresee what may be the turn of public affairs, or what may be the state of the crops for another year; therefore, do nothing rashly, but steadily pursue an even course, and see that you keep out of debt.
