Townsend, architect, has prepared plans for a house to be erected on the west side of Madison avenue, north of Bernard avenue, for William Douglas.—The Public School

Board will ask for tenders for fitting up an additional room in the Winchester and King Edward schools.—The residents east of the Don will petition for the erection of a collegiate institute in the east end of the city.—S. H. 
