The sum of fifteen pounds, to open a road Settlement at Tynemouth to the from the Settlement at Tynemouth, on the Bay of Fundy. Bay of Fundy, to the Quaco road.

The sum of fifteen pounds, for improving Garden's Creek LO Ourco toad the road from Garden's Creek to the Quaco road.

The sum of one hundred pounds, for the Large Loch Loroad leading from the head of the Large mond to Quaco Settlement. Loch Lomond to the Quaco Settlement.

Money to be paid to the persons who isbour.

II. And be it further enacted, That the said several and respective sums of money, and every part thereof, shall be paid to the several and respective persons who shall actually work and labour in making, completing, and repairing the said several roads and bridges, or in furnishing materials therefor, at the most reasonable rates that such labour and materials can be provided; and that the several and respective persons who shall be entrusted with the expenditure of the said Commissioners to several and respective sums, shall keep an exact account of the expenditure thereof, and shall produce receipts, in writing, from the several and respective persons to whom any part of the said money shall be paid, as vouchers for such payment, and shall render an account thereof, upon oath, (which oath any Justice of the Peace in the several and respective Counties, is hereby authorized to administer) to be transmitted to the office of the Secretary of the Province, for the inspection and examination of the General Assembly, at their next Session; and such Commissioners or persons entrusted with the expenditure of the said several and respective sums of money, shall stand charged and charge-

arcount.
