An Act to provide for the Support of certain Charitable Institutions, and for other purposes herein mentioned.

[3d April, 1833.]

Most Gracious Sovereign.

Preamble.

HEREAS it is expedient to appropriate certain Sums of Money in aid of the Institutions hereinafter mentioned: May it therefore please your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth " year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectual pro-" vision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America," and to "make further provision for the Government of the said Province"; and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Government of this Province by Warrant under his Hand, to advance and pay from time to time, during the present year, out of any unappropriated Monies in the hands of the Receiver General of the Province, the sums hereinafter mentioned, that is to say: A sum not exceeding six hundred and fifty-eight pounds, six shillings and eight pence currency, for the support of Insane persons in the cells of the General Hospital at Quebec, from the eleventh of October last until the tenth of October next inclusive. A sum not exceeding five hundred and eleven pounds currency, for the support of the Sick and Infirm persons boarded and lodged in the said Hospital during the same period. A sum not exceeding one hundred pounds currency, to pay for the necessary Clothing for the Sick and Infirm in the said Hospital, during the same period. A sum not exceeding five hundred and eighty pounds currency, for the support of the Foundlings in the Hotel Diêu at Quebec, during the same period. A sum not exceeding fifteen pounds currency, to pay for the necessary Clothing for the said Foundlings, during the same period. A sum not exceeding two hundred pounds currency, for the support of Indigent Sick persons in the said Hospital, during the same period. A sum not exceeding six hundred pounds currency, for the support of the Foundlings in the General Hospital of the Grey Nuns at Mont. real, during the same period. A sum not exceeding two hundred and twenty pounds currency, for the support of the Insane persons in the cells of the said General Hospital, during the same period. A sum not exceeding four hundred pounds currency, for the support of destitute sick persons in the Convent of the Ursuline Nuns in the town of Three Rivers, and for the support of the Insane persons and of the Foundlings
