

**A Profitable Cow.**  
The Holstein cow, Echo, owned by Fred. C. Stevens, proprietor of the Maplewood stock farm, Attica, N. Y., has just completed her year's milk record, which foots up 18,120 pounds, which is 115 pounds more than the record of the famous cow Aggie, which has theretofore led all the bovines of the world. Echo is 10 years old and weighs 610 pounds, consequently has given over 10 times her weight in milk during the year. The largest yield in one day was 85 pounds; in a month 4,196 pounds.

**Cattle for Montana.**
