

This is sufficent to demonstrate that the existing rate of exchange against Canada is not directly due to the cirumstances that the balance of trade between the two countries largely favors the Republic. If, indeed, this were the cause the rate should be auch more favorable than it was either in 1917 or 1913. That the rate of exchange is against Canada in favor of the United States is due directly to the fact that Canada in her ents with the Unied States cannot make use of the large balance which Great Britain owes this country, through the excess of Canadia exports to the Mother Country ove the imports therefrom. If this could be done, the rate of exchange against Canada would not be an appreciable factor.
