

The annexed letter of instruction to the Commanding Officer of the garrison at Fort York, Chateau Bay, by Governor Shuldham is of historical value, in that it contains definite data of the transferring of a certain portion of the Labrador coast to the jurisdiction of Quebec by Act of the British Parliament, thus, to follow out the hypothesis of Mr. Bram Thompson, of Regina, giving to Quebec, not possessive, but certain administrative rights hitherto held by Newfoundland under the Crown. For it must be borne in mind that Quebec as a Crown Colony was not any more entitled to actual possession of lands and territory on the North American continent than was Newfoundland. Quebec at that time had but recently been made possession of the Crown by conquest, and it was thought that a certain portion of Western Labrador, on the littoral of the Laurentian gulf could better be administered by the Quebec authorities, the language and customs of the people using that section being French, than by Newfoundland, whose customs and language were English and out of all sympathy as it were with the French Canadians. It will be noticed that the instruction does not take away from the commander of the garrison the duty of protecting His Majesty's subjects wherever situated on the coast, and emphasises that the Society of United Brethren are to be specifically looked after, the King's authority being in every case conserved to the Crown, which now as then is the court of last resort.
