

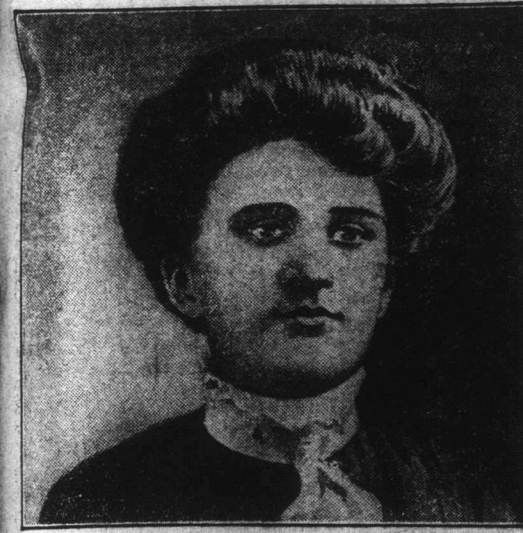

WAS GOLD BRICKED

Interesting Budget of News From the
Orient—Japanese and Chinese
Have Trouble

Victoria, May 12.—The steamer Kamakura Maru which reached port this morning, brought 122 passengers, and 107 tons of cargo including 744 bales of silk worth \$70,000. United States Consul General Selmdore arrived from Korea on the steamer.

He stated that the reports of the annexation of Korea were premature, although events certainly tend in that direction. The insurrection is not serious, being nothing more than a scattered brigandage, Viscount Sone, the resident general, is expected to resign owing to ill health, and Japanese newspapers state that the choice will likely fall between General Viscount Tsuruchi and Admiral Count Yamamoto for his successor.

The statements in some Japanese newspapers that Christian missionaries have been guilty of political intrigue against Japan in Korea are untrue and deprecated by the Japanese officials.

Work is progressing on the Mukden-Ankang railway and the plans for the big steel bridges across the Yalu are in, but there is some delay over a question of jurisdiction with China. Development is progressing at the American mines at Ussuri and it is reported a smelter will shortly be built.

New York, May 12.—At the foreclosure sale of the Metropolitan Street Railway today, no bids were received for the property. The foreclosure proceedings will now go back to the courts and Judge Lacombe will set another date of sale.

HON. FRANK OLIVER
TO VISIT THE WEST

Minister of Interior Will Spend Most of the Summer Travelling in Western Canada.

Ottawa, Ont., May 13.—Hon. Frank Oliver, Minister of the Interior, will spend a week or so and will spend the greater part of the summer there. If he can spare the time, he intends making a trip from Edmonton to the Peace River district and down the Mackenzie river, right to the Arctic ocean, and thence overland to Dawson City. From there he will go to Prince Rupert and Vancouver. He will be accompanied from Edmonton by a detachment of Northwest Mounted Police.
