"When Spring opens it is anticipated that much of the surplus will e on the market.

'In order to prevent possible loss later in the season, the Winter movement of potatoes must be stimulated Potatoes has a large surplus not in great demand for export. No effort should be reach of every family in the Dominion all the potatoes which can be eaten.


