Crazed by Jealousy, Farmer
Slays Spouse in Horrible

Montreal, July 12.—Half crazed by jealousy, a farmer living at Cumberland, in the Province of Quebec, murdered his wife in a horrible manner yesterday afternoon. The body of the woman was found floating in the St. Lawrence river, and the husband was arrested at his home almost immediately. The police are now searching for the husband, who is believed to have fled to the United States. The woman was found with a fatal wound to the chest, and the husband is charged with the murder.
