Galt's seniors dropped the odd ball game at Tecumseh park yesterday afternoon to the scrapping Stratford team 8 to 7, but in doing so gave the Bards a life as far as getting into the playoffs with St. Thomas.

The Bards jumped into the game all set to get back at the locals for stinging them on their home lot. At first things looked hopeless for the visitors due to five husky swats of Mark's. However, the big boy didn't seem to see the situation in the same light, and as a result the Bards had fourteen safeties to their credit after the mix-up.

Three of the fourteen hits gave them two runs in the second frame, three more, coupled with a miscue, brought a pair across in the fourth, and then they passed the locals in the seventh with a trio of counters. The game was further sewed up in the next frame with two hits bringing in a run.

The locals batted all the way around in the first inning. Nolan, who did the receiving duties since Leach hurt his knee in the game in Stratford last Saturday, drew a walk. Armstrong's choice caught him at second, and Reilly sent Armstrong to third on a hit to right. Dougherty brought them both in with a single to center and came galloping home himself on Baker's triple to the signs in left field.

Another run came in the fifth when Reilly scratched a hit off Marks' glove, went to third on Dougherty's lazy fly, and came in on Baker's smash to third.

With two out in the final frame the locals made an energetic attempt at a rally, but stopped short after one lone run was tallied. Armstrong got his first real hit of the game, a triple, between center and left and came in on Reilly's single to right. "Toots" Dougherty came up with the tying run on the paths, but the best he could do was ground out to second.

Dougherty deserves all the credit for the win because, despite wretched support from his teammates, he came through in the pinch in the eighth with the count 6-3, against him by polling out the longest hit of the afternoon which sent three runners scampering home to turn defeat into victory.

Dougherty should have made the out, but when he reached third he was hit by his own team. Dougherty did not win his game, Dougherty did not drive in five of Galt's runs with his two hits. Brantford shot him down in the first after the side should have been retired.
