### TWELFTH YEAR. WARSHIPS SENT TO CORFU.

RIOTING EXTENSIVELY RESUMED  
IN THE ANCIENT CITY.

Many Hebrews shot down in the streets.  
All the Jewish stores closed and their  
owners compelled to remain in  
their homes to prevent being killed—British  
subjects to be protected.

CORFU, May 13.—The anti-Hebrew excitement, which caused an outbreak April 27, is becoming more and more serious. Rioting was renewed. Two Hebrews were killed and a number were injured. Troops dispersed the rioters and now surround the Hebrew quarter. Troops were ordered to pass outside the cordons of troops and all stores kept by Hebrews are closed. The prefect of Corfu has been summoned to Athens to explain the situation to the Government. Troops have been sent here from Athens to restore order.

CORFU IS THE CAPITAL OF THE NOMARCHY OF THE SAME NAME IN THE KINGDOM OF GREECE. It has a population of 15,000 and consists of two parts, the town and island, and has several suburbs. It was the capital of the Ionian Republic.
