THE BETTING BOOKS AT WHITE'S AND BROOKES'S. — In these singular volumes, which still exist, may be found bets on all conceivable subjects — bets on births, deaths, and marriages; on the length of a life, or the duration of a ministry; or a rascal's risk of the halter, or a placeman's prospect of a coronet; on the chances of an election, or the sanity of the king, or the shock of an earthquake, or the last scandal at Ranelagh, or Madame Cornely's. A man dropped down at the door of White's, he was carried into the house. Was he dead or not? The odds were immediately given and taken for and against. It was proposed to bleed him. Those who had taken the odds the man was dead protested that the use of a lancet would affect the fairness of the bet. Walpole has a good story of a parson, who, coming into White's on the morning of the earthquake of 1750, and hearing bets laid whether the shock was caused by an earthquake, or the blowing up of powder-mills, went away in horror, protesting they were such an impious set, that he believed, "if the last trump were to sound, they would bet puppet-show against judgment." One Mr. Blake betted £1,500 that a man could live twelve hours under water; hired a desperate fellow, and sunk him in a ship by way of experiment. Neither ship nor man reappeared. "Another man and ship are to be tried for their lives," adds Walpole, "who is our authority for this story, instead of Blake, the assassin."
