Specific for Streptococcus Infections

A composite Serum containing the antibodies derived from progressively treating with streptococcus cultures, selected horses immunized to diptheria.

Erysipelas, puerperal sepsis, scarlet fever, acute articular rheumatism, the mixed infection of phthisis, septicemia, angina, cellulitis, and certain forms of peritonitis, empyema, lobular pneumonia, caronic bronchitis, endocarditis, arthritis, mastoiditis, otitis and meningitis, comprise the principal affections in which the ravages of the streptococcus are directly or indirectly responsible.

Streptolytic Serum with its composite nature, (antibacterial, antitoxic and agglutinative) and wide range of therapeutic activity has achieved pre-eminence as a rational agent to counteract the inroads of the pathogenic streptococci.

While Streptolytic may be classed as an anti-streptococcic serum, it is essentially different from any and all serums on the market under that title. It is prepared by a special process, and as demonstrated by abundant clinical evidence, possesses an extraordinary effectiveness in overcoming streptococcus infections.

Streptolytic Serum should not be confounded with ineffective anti-streptococcic Serums.
