into the vagina, while an assistant passed a finger into the rectum; then by tarang the handle of the sound, I made its point completely sweep the anterior wall of the pelvis, and in doing so I could distinctly feel it, as it passed by the point of my finger in the cul de sac of the vagina, with nothing but the thin vaginal wall intervening, at the same time my assistant's finger in the rectum distinctly felt the point of the sound, as it passed over the bowel in completing the circuit of the relvis.

We thus became satisfied of the complete absence of the uterus, an atmost total absence of the vagina, and the probable absence of the ouries, but a these latter organs are usually beyond the reach of the finger, their absence or presence was left an open question.

From the well developed breasts, the state of the most reneris, and the occasional experience of strong sexual desires, combined with the usual feminine roice and instincts, one would be inclined to it the ovartes were present somewhere. But on the other hand there had never been anything like that periodical nissis, which is said to mark the return of the catamental epochs in those cases of absent user where the ovartes are known to be present.

Airogethor it would seem as if the chitoris was, after all, the seit to a great extent of the aphrodisia, sense, and case recently reported in which that organ was removed for the rollief of epilepsy, in a girl addicted to musturbation, would, by the success which followed the operation, still further strengthen this view.
